- 3) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT
 - -Robert Vernon reported that the fiscal year ending 2023 audit was complete with findings and has been provided to the Representatives of the Board of Commissioners. Explanation was provided.

- CIRHA purchased two vehicles, both had trade-in values that were not properly
 accounted for and the old vehicles were not removed from the Housing Authority
 inventory records.
- CIRHA had extensive roof and siding damage from storms to Public Housing units that resulted in insurance claims. The timing of the damage, claim approvals, contractor completion, insurance proceeds and payments spanned over two fiscal years. The repairs for roofing and gutters were completed quickly, but the siding repairs took months to negotiate with the insurance company. The Housing Authority did not correctly communicate with the Fee Accountant throughout the process resulting in understated insurance damage and proceeds in fiscal year 2023.

CIRHA is in agreement with the findings and has incorporated changes in the process of providing complete documentation and improving communication with the fee accountant surrounding non-routine transactions.
